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**POLICY:**

1. Education: M.D. or D.O.
2. Training:
  - A. Internal Medicine Residency, and
  - B. Gastroenterology Fellowship, and
  - C. American Board of Internal Medicine Certification with subspecialty Certification in Gastroenterology, and
  - D. EUS training during Gastroenterology Fellowship, or
    - 1) Basic Training: 3 courses of EUS training, documentation of self-study of several diagnostic tools (such as CDs and DVDs) in needle biopsy of mediastinal lymph nodes, staging of esophageal, gastric and rectal cancer, submucosal tumors, fecal incontinence, common bile duct stones and documentation of 50 cases with 15 FNAs.
    - 2) Advanced Training: includes Basic Training plus complex procedures such as staging pancreatic cancer, injection of celiac plexus and drainage of pancreatic pseudocyst, pancreaticobiliary lesions including: pancreas lesions, gallbladder, bile ducts and ampulla and documentation of 125 cases with 40 FNAs
3. Proctoring:
  - A. Three cases with fine needle aspiration
